Rationale for these particular topics

- All very important for patients and practitioners
- An update on them will be good for us all
- Tend to get overlooked due to the pressure of other toxicities/issues
 - Emesis, mucositis, skin toxicity, fatigue, cachexia
- The expertise in today's topics may well be held by non-Oncologists

The unifying patient

- 60 year old woman with bone metastases from breast cancer
 - On Bisphosphanates
- Mildly overweight
- Past history of a DVT when travelling
 - She probably hasn't mentioned it
- Past history of a drug habit when much younger
 - She almost certainly hasn't mentioned it
- We need to remember she could be at risk of all 4 of our chosen toxicities
