

Tip 1: SEARCH!!!!

- Young Medical Oncologists' (YMO) Committee





ESMO-Junior membership

- Open to young oncologists in training (medical, radiation and surgical oncologists)
- Age< 40 years</p>
- Recommendation letter from a full ESMO member (sponsor)
- Annual Junior Membership: 25 Euros
- Free subscription to ESMO newsletter, Annals of Oncology
- Reduced registration fees for ESMO-affiliated events
- ESMO Masterclass
- ESMO Educational visits
- ESMO Fellowships





Fellowship and Award program

ESMO Translational Research Unit or Clinical Research Unit Visit:

- 3-4 visits per year
- Weekly or monthly visit in a recognized ESMOaffiliated academical center in Europe with expertise in the field of translational or clinical research
- Involves acquaintance guided tour in the center, lectures and practical training
- Financial support: 1.000 Euros for weekly and 5.000 Euros for monthly visits

Tip 2: APPLY even if you have a poor CV...especially then!!!

1st ESMO Translational Research Unit (TRU) Visit:

- March 2002
- Institut Gustave Roussy, Paris, France
- 3 participants
- Focus on DNA microarrays

Tip 3: IF YOUR APPLICATION IS REJECTED: RE-APPLY!!!

4th ESMO TRU Visit:

- May 2004
- Cancer Center Karolinska, Stockholm, Sweden
- 10 participants from 8 countries
- Focus on immunobiology of cancer



Education-Creation of a human network







- 3-4 per year, 30-40 participants
- Royal Marsden (London), Jules Bordet (Belgium), IGR (Paris), CCK (Stockholm), INT (Milan), Val d' Hebron (Barcelona), Cancer Centrum (Oslo)
- Many participants had the opportunity to return to their host institutes and get actively involved in academic research projects






Fellowship and Award program

ESMO ANNUAL FELLOWSHIP ON CLINICAL OR TRANSLATIONAL RESEARCH

- Twice per year, 3-6 fellowships every semester
- Duration: 1 year with possibility of prolongation for a second year
- 35.000 Euros per year available on a personal account of the fellowship recipient to help defray the costs of traveling and living in a foreign country




ESMO ANNUAL FELLOWSHIP-REQUIREMENTS:

- Age < 40 years</p>
- ESMO/YMO member, preferably accredited
- Letter of acceptance from the host Institute along with detailed program of the planned research project
- Letter of approval of the training from the applicant's director in the home Institut
- 3 recommendation letters, motivation letter, CV

Tip 4: DON'T HESITATE TO APPLY FOR AN ANNUAL FELLOWSHIP: THIS IS A "WIN-WIN" RELATIONSHIP!!!

IGR, Translational Research fellowship 2005-2006




