OECI Accreditation program : The basics

To promote quality and safety in European cancer institutions, referring to a common set of standards, using a tool based on self evaluation and peer reviews methodology, especially designed for cancer centers




OECI Accreditation Process

- Screening and structuring your own organization
- Objective and independent external peer review





OECI Accreditation: The implementation





The OECI self assessment tool

- Qualitative Questionnaire 64 standards
 - 1. General standards on strategic plan and general management (26)
 - 2. Screening, primary prevention and health education (5)
 - 3. Care (10)
 - 4. Research, innovation and development (14)
 - 5. Teaching and continuing education (3)
 - 6. Patient involvement (6)
- Quantitative Questionnaire



Institut Jules Bordet: 5 good reasons to go through it

- 1. Setting a permanent quality management dynamic
- 2. Getting an <u>actualized picture</u> of the institution
- Identifying needs and <u>areas for improvement</u> and prioritize them
- 4. Developing a **European vision** & visibility
- 5. Strengthening the <u>team spirit</u> by involving the teams and individuals in an integrated quality improvement project
