my conclusions

- This patient has been treated according to ESMO guidelines.
- The aim of treatment in patients with colorectal cancer with liver metastases is complete R0 resection. This can significantly prolong overall survival or even cure in a subset of patients.
- Conversion chemotherapy should be selected to achieve maximum response with chemo doublets or triplets and the use of a MoAb

Conclusions (2)

- There is evidence for the benefit of repeat resection at relapse, but patient selection for this approach remains debatable, has to be made on a individual basis, has still individually unpredictable results and should be discussed with each patient
- The management of each metastatic colorectal cancer is an interdisciplinary effort and remains a clinical challenge...
