# The former traditional role of an oncologist in the MDT

- Male
- "Old & Wise"
- All-knowing
- ..Dominant





Highly respected or highly feared by patients



#### But the patients ask for new roles

- Emancipation by patients; want to be heard, want to communicate..
- Emancipation in the field of medical oncologists: many of them female, part-time working
- Empathetic
- Being more connective, better informed..

- A place for AYA pts themselves in the big hospital
- An AYA out patient clinic
- A better way of communication between patients



#### The role of the medical oncologist here?

To FACILITATE

TO LISTEN, TO ADAPT PROCESSES

TO FIND THE RIGHT PEOPLE



### We started an out patient clinic for AYA age related aspects of the disease











### With input from patients the digital protected AYA4 community was initiated







#### We built an AYA taskforce

- With 4 patients, representing their group
- Medical specialists: orthopedic surgeon, urologist, surgeon, medical oncologist, (fertility-)gynaecologist,
- Experts nurses from hematology, medical oncology
- Social worker and psychologist
- AYA program leader
- Technical chair: senior HRM staff member from concern staff
