

Who are ESMO Young Oncologists (YOs)?

- < 40 years of age
- 36% of ESMO members are YOs
- Comprised of both oncologists in training and specialised oncologists
- Young oncologists who are currently in training i.e. not yet specialised medical, surgical or radiation oncologists can apply for ESMO Junior Membership:
 - €25 per year only giving access to the full range of ESMO benefits including specific benefits aimed at YOs e.g. Fellowship Programme
- Oncologists who have qualified are eligible for Full Membership

- The appraisers add their comments analysing the clinical relevance of the article and possible considerations.





Observation: min 1 months – 2,500€

Research: 1–3 months – 5,000€ (2 or more / year)

1 year – 35,000€ (1 / year)
