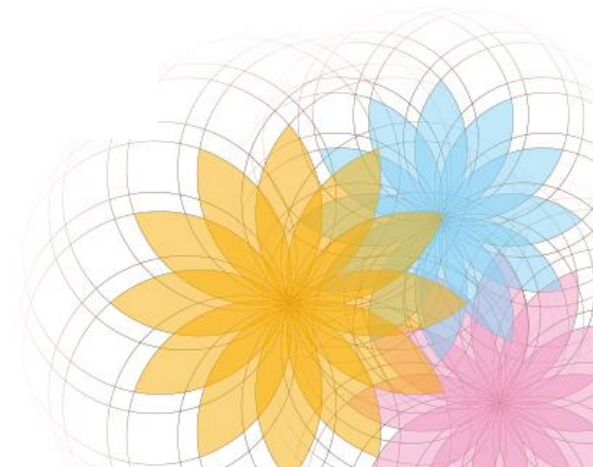

Attendee geographical breakdown

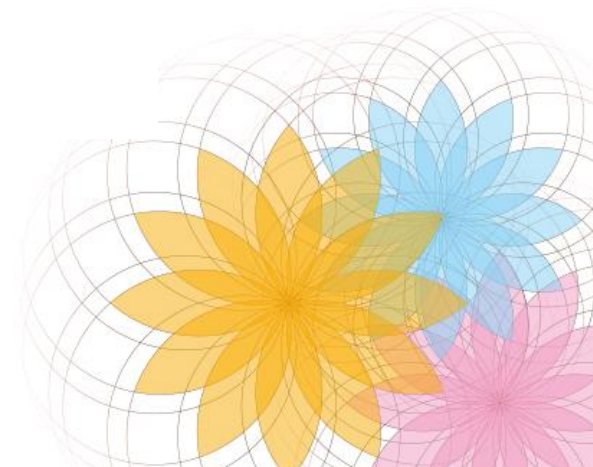
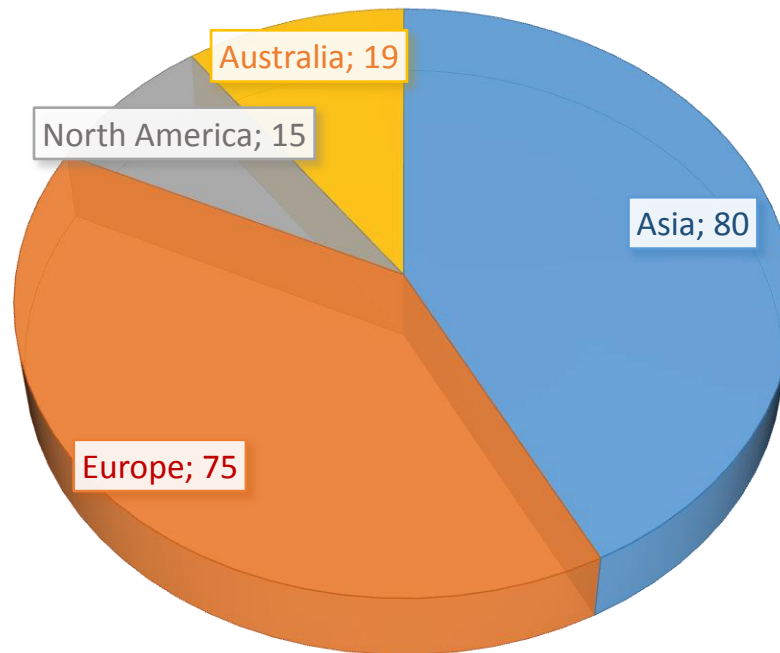
