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65-year-old woman with advanced ovarian cancer

65 year old woman

Presentation: dyspnea, abdominal discomfort, bloating

Co-morbidities: HTN, ECOG 0

MRI of abdomen and pelvis: pelvic mass with peritoneal carcinomatosis

CT chest: effusion in right pleural space

Positive cytology from the pleural fluid – serous carcinoma

Clinical stage: T3cN0M1(PLE), FIGO Stage IV

Chemotherapy in regimen of carboplatin and paclitaxel

CT after Chemotherapy



Treatment course:

PCI – 9

Complete cytoreduction – partial peritonectomy, affected by the tumor, posterior pelvic exenteration, cholecystectomy, splenectomy, omentectomy, colostomy.

CC-0

Pathology: serous adenocarcinoma high-grade,
ypT3cN0M0

There were no postoperative complications. Hospital stay 10 days.
